Extra Credit Guidelines
You can earn up to 5 points of extra credit each quarter where it will be calculated in your participation grade ( $10 \%$ overall grade). To receive 5 points, you must attend one events, site visits or programs and write a review. Please look at the rubric below to show how you can earn full credit.

| 5 Points | Student attends an event, goes to a EE site, <br> or participates in a program and has the <br> extra credit sheet signed by a program <br> leader, office staff, or event staff. Student <br> has typed a well-developed, grammatically <br> correct review of the event, site visit or <br> program that includes what he/she did <br> during the event, site visit or program, what <br> he/she liked or disliked, and if he/she <br> recommends the event, site visit or program. <br> Student will also include an artifact, including <br> but not limiting to picture, program schedule, <br> souvenir, etc. |
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| 3 Points | Student attends an event, goes to an EE site <br> or participates in a program and has the <br> extra credit sheet signed by a program <br> leader, office staff, or event staff. Student <br> has hand-written a review of the event, site |

## Requirements

- Students may only count one events, site visits or programs towards extra credit, but they are encouraged to attend as many events, site visits or programs as possible throughout the school year.
- Students must turn in all extra credit paper work by the last Monday of the quarter to receive credit.
- No double dipping: If you use a site visit for a research project you cannot use it for extra credit
- Each quarter it must be a different event, site visit or program to count towards extra credit
